In order to complete specialty training you need to pass annual reviews and may need to sit membership exams. On successful completion, the Certificate of Completion of training [2] (CCT [3]) is awarded. You can apply for consultant roles six months prior to achieving your Certificate of Completion of Training [2] (CCT [3]).
