Director of public health in conversation

Directors of public health must pursue a programme of continuing professional development in accordance with requirements of the Faculty of Public Health or other recognised bodies.

They must also undertake a process of revalidation required to stay on the <u>GMC</u> [1] or <u>GDC</u> Specialist Register [2], the UKPHR [3], or another specialist register as appropriate.
