Read about the skills that public health consultants and specialists need.

Some of the skills and qualities you'll need as a public health consultant or specialist include:

- flexibility to cope with multiple and changing demands
- ability to meet tight deadlines
- high level of intellectual rigour
- political awareness, tact, and diplomacy
- ability to understand other cultures
- ability to work across organisational boundaries
- ability to advise, challenge, and advocate
- negotiation and motivation skills
- ability to influence without having direct authority



You'll need flexibility to cope with multiple and changing demands.
