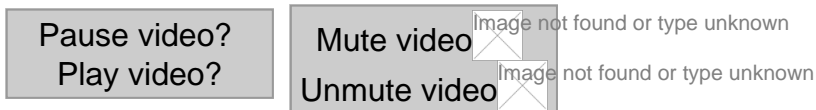


"I'm proud of my 18-year career in the NHS. I'm still progressing."
