This graduate programme prepares you for for a career as a chartered surveyor.

The Programme

The NHS Graduate Surveyor Trainee Programme [1] gives you the opportunity to gain full Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) [2] membership and chartered surveyor status.

The Programme lasts for two years and you spend six months with four different teams. You gain a range of practical experience and continuing professional development (CPD) [3].



Entry requirements

You'll need a degree accredited by the RICS [2].
