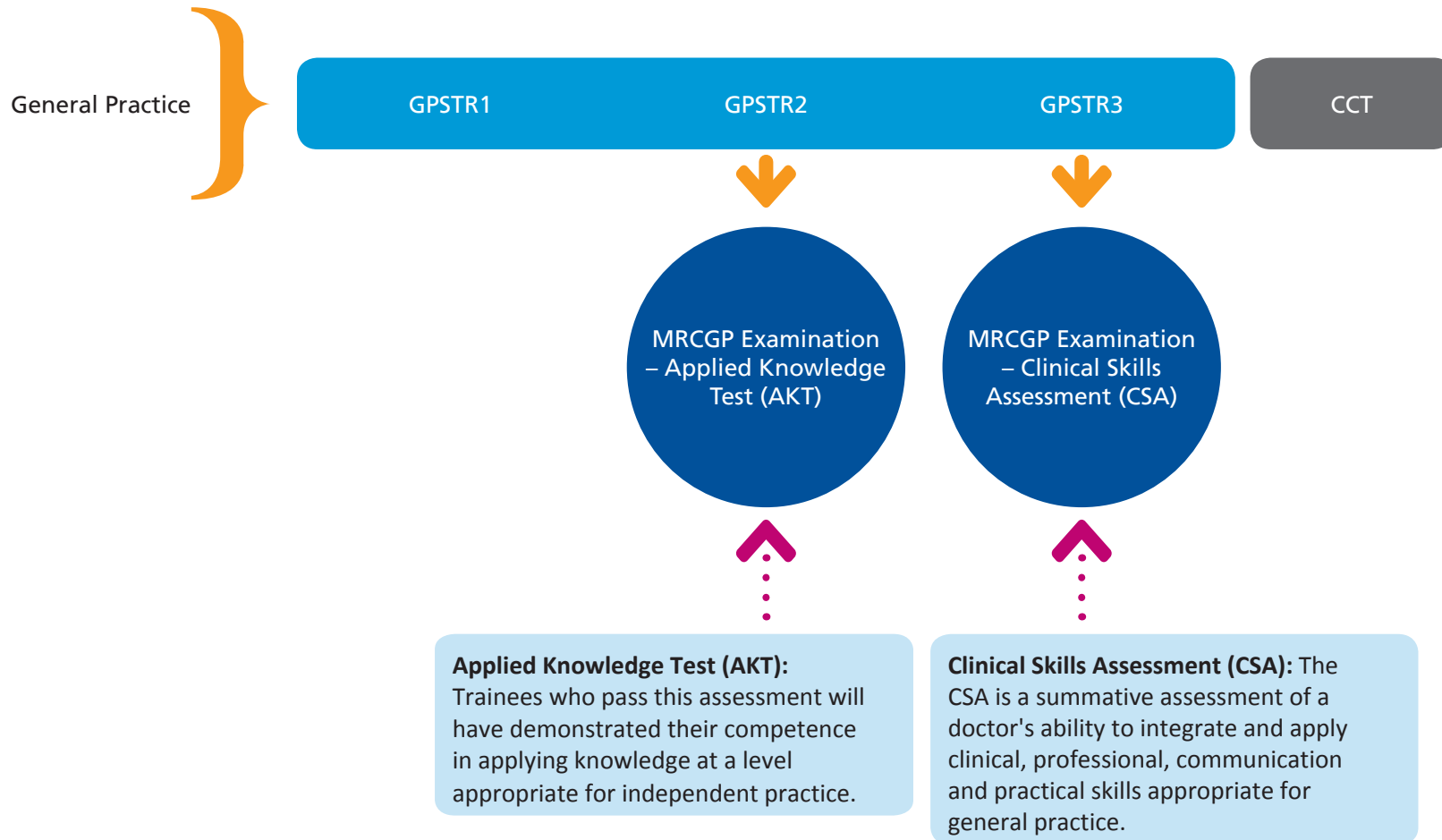


General Practice (GP) training pathway (Royal College of General Practitioners - RCGP)

Trainees must spend a minimum of 12 months in hospital posts and a minimum of 12 months, but ideally 18 months, in GP. Post length in hospital varies but is usually between 3 and 6 months

GPSTR - General Practice Specialty Registrar
CCT - Certificate of Completion of Training
