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**CAMPAIGN OVERVIEW** 

Being a nurse or midwife is something that never really leaves you. It's part of who you are.

This is the starting point of our Return to Practice campaign and what all the assets in this toolkit revolve around.

By using the stories and photos of real nurses and midwives, our assets aim to inform and inspire other former nurses and midwives to rejoin the NHS.

This toolkit contains everything you need to support your recruitment activities, from films and social posts to share online, to posters and informative leaflets to place in NHS organisations.

The toolkit contains a broad range of assets belonging to the campaign, but which ones your NHS organisation uses will be up to you.





#### **HOW TO USE THE CAMPAIGN ASSETS**

#### **PRINTED ASSETS**

- The posters and flyers in this toolkit are in print-ready PDF files, so you can simply print them off (either in your organisation, or at a professional printer).
- If it's necessary to tweak the wording to include your local offer, an InDesign file is also available.
- The flyers and posters come in two versions; a clean version, and a customisable version.
- The "clean" versions can be hung, shared and placed in your organisation as they are.
- The customisable versions have a white box at the bottom for you to write your contact details in.

#### **DIGITAL ASSETS**

- Social media activity is always an important part of our campaigns, as we know there is a strong online community of midwives and nurses who have previously left their roles in the NHS.
- The films and social media images in this toolkit are ready to be shared on your organisation's Facebook, Twitter and Instagram pages.
- The films can also be included in your newsletters and on your website.
- For ease, the accompanying text to go along the social media posts has already been written.
- There are two accompanying text options per image, but our recommendation would be to use the first options, as they help tell the individual stories of our nurses and midwives.
- Please note that as the posts call the midwives and nurses by name, so it is important not to mix them.
- The accompanying post texts also include hyperlinks to the specific nursing and midwifery Return to Practice pages, so potential returners can continue their journey back to practice.
