INTRODUCTION

Recruiting former nurses isn't an easy task, but it is a vital one. We want to help make your job that little bit easier, which is why we've created this Return to Practice toolkit. It contains everything you need to support your recruitment activities, from leaflets and emails to event banners – saving you the time and effort of designing and writing them all yourself.

This toolkit also means that now the NHS' recruitment for former nurses will be unified across the UK – although which bits you use and how you adapt them is up to you.

HOW DO I USE THE TOOLKIT?

Printed items

These are print-ready, so you can simply print them off – although the pull-up banners are large so would need to be printed at a professional printer. Use the flyers and leaflets to hand out wherever and whenever, while the posters and pull-up banners are perfect for local events.

The flyers, leaflets and posters come in two versions. One directs people to our online email guide for more information, while the other lets you write in your contact details.

Digital templates

These are for all your digital communications and social activity. For instance, you might collate an email database at an event and want to follow up with an email. Or perhaps there are nurses you can reach more effectively on twitter? Use these digital templates as a base, amending and adding where you see fit.

PRINT MATERIALS

TRI-FOLD LEAFLET

These outline the ways we're making it easier for people to return to practice. They offer more detail than our posters, and will direct people to online resources. They could also be displayed at local establishments or handed out at career events to people looking for more information.

If you're hosting an event such as an information day, pull up banners are ideal way of dressing the event space or room quickly, as well as making a big impact.





DOUBLE-SIDED FLYER

Similar to the posters and leaflets, you could display them at local cafes, GPs or distribute them to career advisors or universities to have available to hand out to anyone who might be interest in returning to nursing. These may also be suitable for people who are a little more familiar with what Returning to Practice involves, encouraging them to find our more online.
