Returning to practice is easier than you think.

- There's more than one way back:
Readmission - If you meet the NMC requirements.
RTP course - With both classroom and placement-based learning.
NMC Test of Competence - A mix of an online test and a practical test.
- If you choose to do an RTP course through a university, your fees will be paid and you'll get an extra £1,000 for travel, childcare and books. If you choose to do an RTP course through a Trust, your fees will be paid, and you'll receive a salary or £1,000.
- If doing the NMC Test, your fees will either be paid for by your employer, or refunded once you've rejoined the register and started a job with the NHS.
- You'll also find opportunities to study and work part-time.
